D. 1891.

Respectfully Represents David Robinson of Portland in the County of Cumberland an alien and a free white person, and that he was born in Russia in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland

on or about the fifth day of May eighteen hundred and fifty-one and is now about fifty years of age; that he arrived at Philadelphia in the United States of America, on or about the 15th day of September in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-two; and that it then was, and still is his bona fide intention to reside in and become a Citizen of the United States of America, and to renounce all allegiance and fidelity to every Foreign Prince, State, Potentate, and Sovereignty, whatsoever, more especially to the Czar of Russia of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland

whose subject he has heretofore been; all of which appears in the record of this honorable Court to wit at the October Term thereof, A. D. 1895, a copy of which duly authenticated, he here in Court produces.

And the said David Robinson further represents that he has ever since September 15 A. D. 1893 continued to reside within the jurisdiction of said United States; that he has never borne any hereditary title, or been of any of the order of nobility; that he is ready to renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to the Czar of Russia as aforesaid, whose subject he has heretofore been; that he is attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States of America, and well disposed towards the good order and happiness of the same.

Wherefore your Petitioner prays that he may be admitted to become a Citizen of said United States of America, according to the forms of the statutes in such case made and provided.
