Following my visit I beg to have the privilege of explaining
my present position in France.

I am an American naturalized citizen. I have lived in France
since 1919, am interested commercially in the "Maison Blanc"
Boulevard Auguste Blenqui, Paris, and I count on remaining
here still some time, but I do not know how long, then I mean
set up in business for myself.

The firm I intend to establish would do business in raw
materials for the industry of paper, and would have especially
principal customers in America: moreover that would be its
reason for my setting up such a business and making it
profitable. So I should, naturally, found a branch in America.

I should like to add that my wife and son, who accom-
panied me to France in 1919, have been in America since 1922.
