I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 20 day of June, anno Domini 1913, and in the State of MASSACHUSETTS, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 29 day of August, anno Domini 1918, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court.
