### Description:

This database is an index to the passenger lists of ships arriving from foreign ports at the port of Boston, Massachusetts, USA, from 1820-1943. ### **BTS:**

I am not certain that this is our Isaac, but I think it is more than likely that it is.

The name—Stasowsky as a variant of Stasewich—is not impossible.

The 1910 Census records that his year of Immigration was 1906.

He did not travel with his family in 1907.

In September 1910 he returned from a trip to England as a Non Immigrant Alien, so that was not his first arrival in the US.

The 1906 Ivernia manifest lists Isaac Stasowsky as a tailor, age 33 (presumed birth 1873), married, able to read and write, of the Hebrew people, from Russia, a ten-year resident of England, carrying \$30.00. All this is consistent with Isaac as we know him.

Interestingly, in New York he will join his friend, Israel Mattan, on Suffolk Street.
