The Oakland Symphony Association in conjunction with a Board of Directors of instrumental teachers are reorganizing the Northern California Honor Orchestra into the Youth Chamber Orchestra. The Youth Chamber Orchestra will perform 18th century and contemporary chamber music.

Robert Hughes, assistant conductor of the Oakland Symphony, will be the regular conductor of the orchestra and Gerhard Samuel, conductor and musical director of the Oakland Symphony will act as guest conductor for our concerts. The orchestra will rehearse on Saturday mornings at Oakland Technical High School Auditorium, 42nd and Broadway, Oakland. Rehearsals of the orchestra will begin October 3rd at 9:00 a.m., and each Saturday thereafter until Easter vacation, with the exceptions of holidays and a few Saturdays where a conflict exists.

Membership in the orchestra will be determined by auditions. These auditions will be held at Oakland Technical High School auditorium on Saturday morning, September 26th, beginning at 9:00 a.m.

The first requisite for membership in the orchestra is that the student be a member in good standing of his or her school music organization (band or orchestra). A participation fee of \$6.00 is charged to take care of music, materials, and administrative expenses.

In addition to the usual student soloists who regularly perform with the orchestra in concert there will be one concert in which a professional concert artist will appear with the orchestra as soloist.

Students must complete the application and return with participation fee, to the address given on the blank. Applications must be postmarked not later than Monday, September 21st. Applicants will present themselves at Oakland Technical High School on Saturday morning, September 26th. NO ADDITIONAL NOTICE OR REMINDER WILL BE SENT RELATIVE TO THESE AUDITIONS.

We are convinced that this is a most wonderful opportunity for your more advanced players to receive an additional challenge on their instruments. They should become more proficient performers as a result of participation in this orchestra.
